## **MEOPHAM CRICKET CLUB**

### **Constitution of the Club as adopted at the Annual General Meeting on Friday, 1st December 1995 (Updated July 2003)**

The Constitution of Meopham Cricket Club as set out in the rules herein is to be used as a supplement to the Membership Card issued to all Members at the start of each season. The Membership Card shall list the Members of the Committee, the Officers, the fixtures for the season and such other information as the Committee shall decide from time to time

#### **NAME**

1. The name of the Club shall be "Meopham Cricket Club"

#### **PURPOSE**

2. The Club shall exist for the furtherance of the game of cricket on Meopham Green

#### **ADDRESS**

3. The headquarters of the Club shall be The Pavilion Meopham Green, Meopham. Kent

#### **COLOURS**

4. The Club colours shall be navy blue and white; its insignia shall be the Windmill.

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

5. The Club shall consist of a President, Vice Presidents. Playing Members. Associate Members, and Junior Family Associate Members.

#### **MANAGEMENT**

6. The Club shall be managed by a General Committee ("Committee"), who will vest any property or leases in three Trustees who shall be Members of the Club. The Committee of 17 shall consist of the following Officers and Members, who shall be elected at the General; Meeting Chairman, Hon Secretary, Hon Treasurer, the Captains of the two Senior Saturday XI's and the two Senior Sunday XI's, Hon Fixture Secretary. Hon Team Secretary. Hon Junior Organiser, and six other elected members. The Committee shall regulate its meetings and may fill all casual vacancies. The quorum of the Committee shall be five of the elected Officers and Members detailed above. The Committee may appoint subcommittees of two or more Members for particular purposes, and may delegate its powers to such subcommittees at its discretion. The Committee has the power to disqualify from its Membership any individual who fails to attend three consecutive meetings.

## **TRUSTEES**

7. The property of the Club shall be vested in three Trustees, who shall be Members of the Club and appointed by a General Committee, to be dealt with by them as the Committee may from time to time direct by resolution (of which an entry in the Minute Book shall be conclusive evidence). The Trustees shall be indemnified against risk and expense out of the Club property. The Trustees may hold Office for three years or until otherwise replaced at a General Meeting of the Club, when, by reason of death, resignation or replacement it is necessary that a new Trustee or Trustees be appointed by the Members at a General Meeting, the Committee shall nominate the person or persons to be appointed. For the purposes of giving effect to such nomination, the Hon. Secretary is hereby nominated as the person to appoint new Trustees of the Club within the meaning of Section 3k of the Trustee Act 1925 and shall by deed duly appoint the person or persons nominated

## **SELECTION: PRIZES**

8. The selection of Cricket Teams and the disposition of prizes shall be the duty of the Selection Committee who shall consist of Captains, Vice Captains, Chairman, and Hon. Team Secretary

## **ELECTION**

9a Candidates for election to Playing Membership must be proposed by a Member, and seconded by a Member of the Committee, their names and addresses shall be posted by the Hon Secretary on the Notice board in the Club Headquarters. Any objection to a candidate should be made to the Hon Secretary or Member of the Committee within fourteen days that such notice shall remain displayed. Candidates shall be considered at the next meeting of the Committee, when in the event of a ballot, applications for Membership will be decided by a simple majority vote. No one shall enjoy the privilege of Membership until an appropriate subscription is paid.

9b. The appointment of Vice Presidents is reserved for those Members (or former Members) who have rendered valued services to the Club over a long period. They are life appointments. Honorary Membership is reserved for those persons who are distinguished persons in their own right and who, in the opinion of the Committee, will help to preserve the best traditions of the Village Green. Honorary Membership is renewable annually. Associate Members are admitted to the Club on application and on payment of a subscription.

## **MEETINGS**

10. An Annual General Meeting (A.G.M.) shall be held in January each year at such time, date and place as the Committee decides. On the occurrence of a vacancy in the Office of President, a Member on the nomination of the Committee shall be appointed at a General Meeting for a period of three years A President is eligible to be nominated for reappointment at the end of his term of office.

At each A G M the Vice Presidents, Chairman, Hon Secretary, Hon Treasurer, Hon Fixture Secretary, Hon Team Secretary, Hon Juniors' Secretary, Hon Social Secretary, Captains, and Members of the Committee, who must be Members of the Club, together with the Hon Archivist and Hon Auditor shall be elected. Any Member wishing to propose candidates for Vice President must give notice to the Hon Secretary at least 21 days prior to the A G M. Those proposed candidates may only be submitted for election after acceptance of the nominations by the Committee. An Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) may be convened by the Committee whenever it thinks fit or otherwise upon a request to the Hon Secretary in writing by at least ten Members who must detail, in the form a Resolution the object of the EGM. Fourteen clear days notice of an EGM specifying date, place, time and object shall be given to every Member. Only the object and its Resolution(s) may be discussed at an EGM. The quorum for the General Meeting shall be 17 Members.

### **PROCEDURE OF MEETINGS**

11. All decisions shall be by majority vote by those Members present accept amendments to Rules when at least two-thirds of Members present and voting should be in favour. The Hon Secretary shall keep the minutes of all meetings; the Minutes shall be approved by the succeeding meeting, as relevant, and signed by the Chairman. The Hon Secretary shall retain on record a copy of all letters written at the request of a meeting or Committee. The Chairman shall take the Chair at every meeting except a General Meeting where the President shall take the Chair.

### **ACCOUNTS**

12. Books and Accounts shall be kept by the Hon Treasurer who will operate a separate bank account in the name of the Club. The Accounts of the Club shall be examined by the Hon Auditor and the Committee shall approve the accounts before they may be presented in a detailed statement to the Members at an AG M. The Committee shall have the power to call upon all Trustees, Members, President and Vice Presidents to make up any deficit.

### **SUBSCRIPTION AND MEMBERSHIP**

13. Subscriptions for the ensuing year and Match Fees shall be fixed at an AGM and shall be due on such dates as fixed by the Committee. Any Member failing to pay the subscriptions by its due date shall cease to be a Member of the Club. If a member has not paid his club subscriptions by 30 June then he shall be required to pay an additional £5 per month to the agreed annual subscription. Members shall mean only those individuals who shall have paid and be current within the relevant subscription

The Committee shall have the right to reduce the subscription from time to time of any Member not in full employment and where circumstances warrant.

Membership shall be open to all irrespective of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, creed colour, social status and sexual orientation.

All Members, including the President, Vice Presidents and Trustees, who must also be Members, shall have the right to vote at General Meetings, except Associate Members and Junior Family Associate Members who may not vote on the election of Captains and amendments to rules unless they have paid a subscription equivalent to that of a full Playing Member. An Honorary Member has no voting rights.

Any Member desirous of withdrawing from the Club shall give notice in writing to the Hon Secretary before 1st May otherwise a full subscription will be due for the year.

### **EXPULSION**

14. The Committee shall, by two-thirds majority, have the power to expel any Member whose conduct is likely to affect prejudicially the welfare and or the reputation of the Club.

### **RULES**

15. The Rules of the Club may only be changed in a General Meeting where Notice of such proposed change shall have been given to the Hon Secretary in writing 21 days before the General Meeting. Every Member shall be bound by the Rules, a copy of which shall be given to every Member, on election, by the Hon Secretary.

### **DISSOLUTION**

16. If at any General Meeting a resolution for the dissolution of the club is passed by a majority of the members present and at a Special General Meeting held not less than 6 weeks later (of which not less than 4 weeks written notice has been given to each member) and at which not less than one half of the members are present that resolution is confirmed by a resolution passed by a majority of two thirds of the members voting on it the Committee must immediately or at such future date as is specified in the resolution proceed to realize the assets of the Club and after the discharge of all liabilities such assets shall be transferred, subject to members approval to any organisations with similar aims and objectives.

### **INDEMNITY**

17. The Club shall indemnify the Officers, Trustees and Committee Members against any liability incurred by them solely by reason of their holding office.

## **Code of Conduct**

Cricket is played for enjoyment. Be fair, positive and have fun.

At Meopham Cricket Club, we expect the highest standards of sportsmanship to be displayed by all Club Members, whether they be players, officials, parents or spectators, along with their guests, both on and off the field.

Participation, at whatever level and in whatever capacity, should always reflect the "spirit of the game".

All participants should be treated with the utmost respect. The use of crude or abusive language, or offensive gestures, will not be tolerated. Similarly, any conduct which offends, insults, humiliates, intimidates, threatens, disparages or vilifies any other person on the basis of that person's race, religion, colour, descent or national or ethical origin will not be deemed acceptable.

The game should be played to win, solely within the laws of the game.

Decisions of the Captain and Umpires should be accepted immediately, without openly expressing dissent.

A sporting attitude is to be encouraged. Appreciate good play on either side, and appeal sensibly, but only when in an appropriate position to do so.

Be a good loser and a gracious winner.

Attempt to be helpful to the best of your abilities, and always co-operate.

Respect the Club's premises, equipment and facilities, and those of any host club or venue.

Work hard for your Club. No individual is more important than the Club.

Assist in the maintenance and upkeep of the ground, particularly in preparing for and clearing up after games.

Always provide good role models for younger, less-experienced members.

### **Disciplinary Measures**

At the Club Committee's discretion:

- Immediate removal from the present game, activity or function
- Suspension from the Club's immediate fixtures or activities
- Expulsion from the Club
